THE BLACK WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP COLLECTIVE SAYS 'ITS TIME' FOR JUDGE KETANJI BROWN JACKSON TO BE CONFIRMED

Following an 11-11 vote on Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson's nomination to the Supreme Court by the Senate Judiciary Committee, and a vote by the Senate to advance her nomination for a confirmation vote by the full senate, the Black Women's Leadership Collective, issued the following statement:

"Today Democrats on the Senate Judiciary Committee affirmed what a majority of Americans, President Biden, Vice President Harris, a broad coalition of faith leaders, law enforcement officials, the American Bar Association, legal experts from across the political spectrum, and Black women across our country already know, that Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson belongs on the U.S. Supreme Court. Time and again Judge Jackson has been rightly praised for her brilliance, unwavering integrity, dedication to our constitution and the rule of law. We congratulate Judge Jackson and her family on moving a step closer to making history as the first Black woman to serve on the U.S. Supreme Court. Our message to the U.S. Senate in advance of the confirmation vote to be held later this week is simple: its time!"
